

Raising awareness of missing and murdered indigenous people



The Solidarity Network- Rapid Response Monterey County has confirmed that two individuals were detained by immigration authorities in Salinas on Wednesday, April 8, 2025. The first man was detained outside his home in the morning while taking out the garbage. Details of the second detention remain unclear. It is also unclear whether these persons had deportation orders or any other pending case with immigration authorities.

The Network reminds community members to be vigilant. Persons with pending immigration cases should be aware of their surroundings and report potential enforcement vehicles to the Rapid Response Hotline, 831 204-8082. Legal Observers can be dispatched to confirm whether immigration officials are present and document encounters to prevent abuse.

Also, community members should remember that certain rights are granted to people living in the United States, regardless of their immigration status. Do not sign anything. Get a red card and show it to immigration officials. Call an immigration attorney to get assistance with your case or call the Rapid Response Hotline for a referral.
